2023 saw UWE FS take on 2 competitions, one in the Netherlands at TT Assen circuit and the other at Silverstone. We managed to place 8th at both competitions with strong results in many events. Whilst we are proud of our achievements as a team, we are also disappointed as we feel our car had more to give.



Let's start with the highlights:

- At both events we passed scrutineering, performed well in the static events and took part in all dynamic events which is a great achievement for any Formula Student team.
- We made the finals of the costing event at FSUK finishing 4th overall.
- We came 3rd overall in the sprint event at FSUK despite some less than ideal weather and track conditions, against other teams which ran on a range of drying track conditions.



However, due to a post event scrutineering failure after the endurance portion of the Formula Student Netherlands competition, we were disqualified from the endurance event causing us to lose out on a large chunk of points. Unfortunately, our bad luck carried over to the UK competition, as an electrical failure caused us to DNF the endurance event, when we were on course for a podium place finish. Due to these failures, we lost out on a large number of points last season leading to us not gaining any world ranking positions.
